NB:

1. The **medical fee** is excluded from tuition & administrative fees.

Those who have valid health insurance may opt to use the services provided by their health insurance company recognized by Morogoro Regional Hospital (NHIF, SUA, Jubilee, AAR, NSSF, TANESCO, Strategis), but have to ensure their cards are verified and registered by the Finance office during registration period.

At the time of registration, the insurance cards should be valid for at least 9 months. For all others, the medical fee is compulsory (80,000 TZS per year) and should be paid during registration to avoid penalty.

Deadline for registration for the academic year 2020/2021 is 14 December 2020!

2. An academic year has two semesters, each lasting for 120 days.
3. Coursework Duration:
For MBA it is 1 academic year (2 semesters).
After that expected time for completion of Dissertation is about 120 – 180 days.
For MED, MRSED and MAPH it is 3 semesters.
After that expected time for completion of Dissertation is about 120 days.
4. Books expenditure is ranging from Tshs 200,000 to 300,000, depending on sponsor's financial ability.
5. Books, stationary & meals allowance are paid direct to the student and may vary according to sponsors' policies and if paid through JUCo accounts will not be refunded in any case.
6. Payment for your accommodation in the College hostel (400,000 TZS) can only be made after being informed that there is vacancy for you.
You will then be required to present to the Dean of Students or Warden the payment receipt.
The payment for the College Hostel should be paid to the accommodation account

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Remember to indicate in memo that the payment is for accommodation.

Accommodation fee may be paid in 2 instalments of 200,000 at the beginning of each semester.

7. Cost of borrowing or purchasing graduation gown is not included
8. Grade report on request will be charged TZS 5,000/=
9. **Penalty** will be charged for any late payment of registration fee and medical fee.
Late payment of registration fee is: 50,000 TZS.
Late payment of other instalments: 25,000 TZS in each instalment.
10. Fees are subjected to changes.
11. TCU QA Fee is collected by the College on behalf of TCU.

4. Purpose of payment (be specific, e.g.: registration fee, or tuition and administrative fees, or provisional results)
